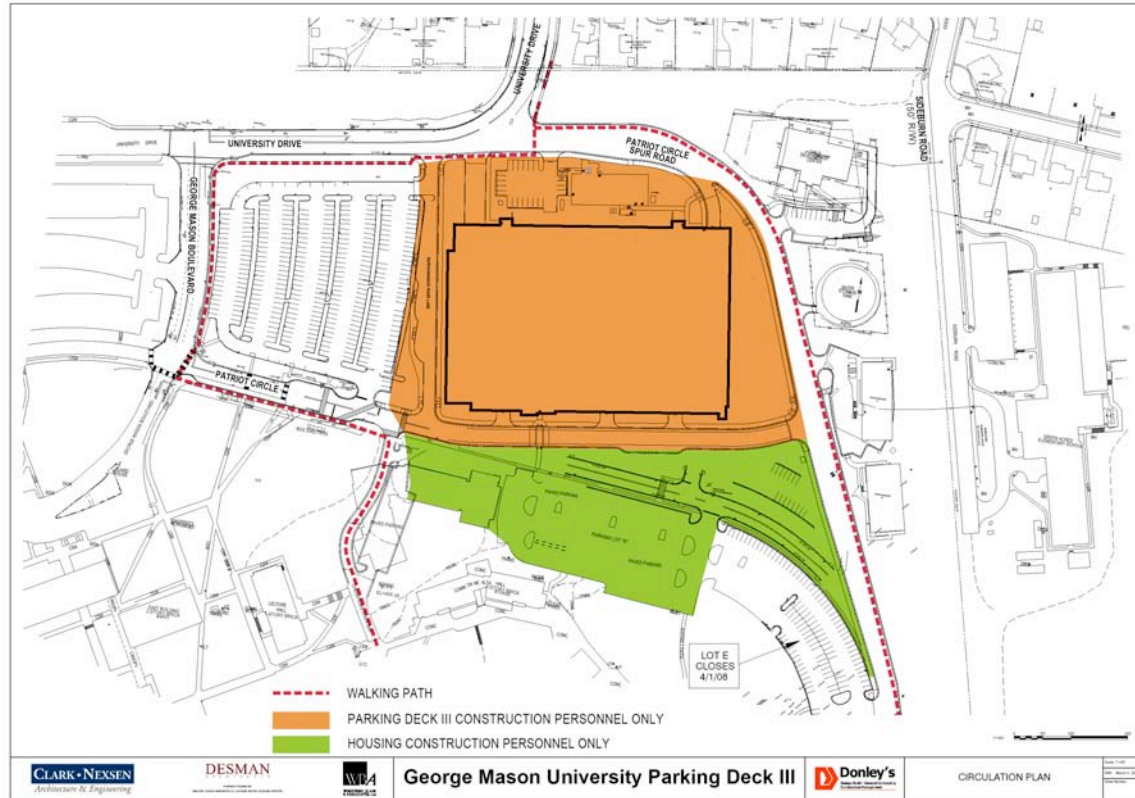

New Intersection @ University Dr.

- Patriot Circle Spur (the Spur) opened March 6, 2008
 - The Spur is first phase of the Parking Deck III project
 - 2600 spaces on NE corner of campus by the water tower
 - Deck will open in Fall 2009

New Intersection @ University Dr.

- Created new intersection at University Dr
 - New traffic patterns
 - Per VDOT, through traffic on the Spur as it connects to/from University Dr has right-of-way
 - Traffic from Rt. 123 turning left to remain on University Dr towards downtown Fairfax must yield to traffic on the Spur
 - Intersection not in permanent configuration as it will change once City of Fairfax dead-ends University Dr when it extends George Mason Blvd into the city

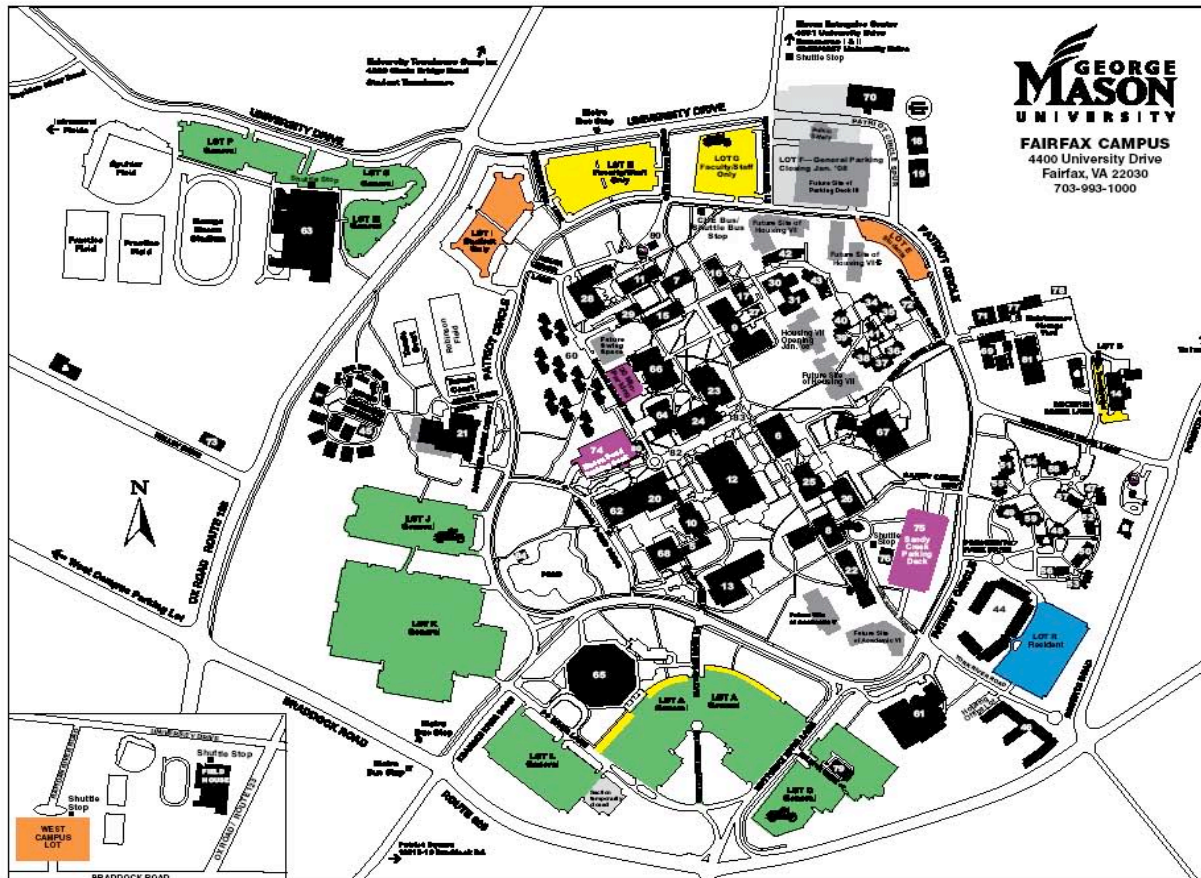
New Intersection @ University Dr

- Mason has/will work with City, County, and VDOT to monitor new road-traffic and pedestrian patterns
- County Sherriff's have helped with "no parking" enforcement further down University Dr near Metro bus stop
- With opening of the Spur, a portion of Patriot Circle on the NE part of campus was closed to allow construction of next resident student housing project
- New signage being developed to guide visitors to certain parts of campus with new traffic patterns in effect
 - Will also be done with VDOT on roads approaching campus such as Braddock, Roberts, Rt.123, and University Dr

Hotel/Conference Center

New road off of Rt.123 to start construction this summer as part of the new Hotel/Conference Center

- 150 room hotel
- 20,000 sq ft conference center
- New road off Rt.123 will be right-turn only in to campus and right-turn only off campus
- Road to serve as construction entrance until completion of hotel
- Road will connect all the way to Patriot Circle where a roundabout is being constructed Summer 2008
 - Will require internal detours on campus during construction

Additional Parking Being Built

- Additional parking spaces being built on campus this summer
 - 120 spaces being added to existing lots
 - New lot of 320 spaces for resident students
- Parking Deck III underway
 - 2600 spaces
 - Open Fall 2009

Transportation-As it is Now

- Mason/CUE Bus
 - 368,000 trips last year by Mason students, faculty, and staff
- Mason Shuttles
 - Mason to Metro shuttle-9000 trips per month
 - Fairfax-Prince William shuttle-7000 trips per month
 - West Campus shuttle-for resident students parking in remote storage lot
 - Field House Express-transportes students back and forth from the Field House lots west of Rt.123 off University Dr to the east campus

Transportation-continued

- Employees can receive up to \$115/month in Smart Benefits/Commuter Checks for using alternative means of transportation
- Bicycling
 - Mason and County working on bicycle maps to help provide information for bicycling to campus
 - *Bike to Mason Day being held on April 22nd to promote bicycling as an alternative to driving to campus*

Transportation-The Future?

- Possible shuttle or partnership with County on shuttle to Burke VRE station
- -Possible shuttle to surrounding neighborhoods similar to Univ of MD shuttles around College Park
- Possible shuttle to University Mall/Fair Oaks Mall or other destinations
- Possible partnership with County for Fairfax Connector buses similar to CUE bus arrangement with City of Fairfax
